All programs (film screenings and fringe events) aim to be accessed by the public for free of charge.

Established since 2017 under a non-profit organisation, Bhinneka Cipta Setara (BCS), 100% Manusia Film Festival runs on a voluntary basis from various backgrounds of professions. We share a vision of a tolerant Indonesia as a safe and peaceful home for all people without discrimination. As part of the initiatives, BCS also supports film festivals in Indonesia who share social perspectives such as Europe on Screen, 16 FilmFestival and Bebas Batas Festival.

In 2025, 100% Manusia Film Festival enters its 9th edition by actively engaging in various collaborations with local and international film festivals.





His notable documentary work includes La Laguna del Soldado (2024), Eastern Anthems (2024), and Bedrock (2025). Through his works, he has won SACEM Award for Best Original Music at Cinéma du réel 2024 and obtained nominees for Outstanding Achievement in Sound Design at Cinema Eye Honors 2025, and Best Sound Design in a Feature Length Documentary at Canadian Screen Awards 2025.

His approach to sound is holistic, often accompanying films through the entirety of the auditory process; he views recording, design, and mixing as a unified creative discipline. His sensibility ranges from subtle natural realism to abrasive dissonance, often blurring the lines between music and sound, with a fixation on how sound subconsciously transports us from the concrete to the abstract.
